

Brexit & Green Cards – Advice for MS Amlin policyholders

Dear Policyholder,

What has happened?

Given ongoing negotiations between the UK and the European Union (“EU”), it looks unlikely we will have a post-Brexit deal in place once the current transition period ends on the 31st December 2020.

UK motorists travelling in and through the EU will be required to prove they have adequate insurance in place, through the use of a Green Card.

What this means for you.

MS Amlin has taken steps to ensure we are in a position to print and issue Green Cards to policyholders who require them.

If you intend to use your vehicle within the EU, you will need to request a Green Card by contacting your insurance broker or intermediary. They will confirm your requirements to MS Amlin, who will issue your Green Card.

If you are a UK policyholder intending to use your vehicle(s) within the EU, please get in touch with your broker at least **5 working days** prior to departure, providing the following details:

- Name of person requesting Green Card
- Contact Telephone number
- Contact e-mail address
- Policyholder Name
- Policy Number
- Dates of Travel
- Countries required
- Vehicle Registration Mark
- Vehicle Make & Model
- Trailer Identification Number & Type

For Irish policyholders who have Irish registered vehicles insured with MS Amlin and wish to travel between Ireland and the UK, you do not require a Green Card. The UK government has advised Motor Insurers’ Bureau of Ireland (MIBI) that they will accept valid Irish insurance discs from Irish registered vehicles as proof of insurance.

You should also be aware you may be required to apply for an International Driving Permit, and one permit is not necessarily universally accepted across the EU.
