Recently we confirmed that as part of our plan to phase the re-opening of our offices in the UK, a multi-disciplinary taskforce was reviewing the options to ensure we can do so in a safe and controlled way, protecting our people whilst maintaining operational resilience and effectiveness. As a result, we can confirm that most of our UK offices will begin to partially reopen from **Monday 15th June**. The majority of our global offices have already partially reopened.

Accessing our UK offices

We have developed measures that follow the latest Government and Public Health England guidance, therefore the advice to our people is that they must continue to work from home as this is still the safest place to be, unless it is absolutely necessary to come into the office.

Access to our offices will be heavily restricted. All requests must meet specific criteria and will require prior line management approval. Due to the need to maintain social distancing, we anticipate lengthy delays in gaining access to lifts and public areas.

As noted previously on 18th May it will be some time before external visitors are able to have access to our offices. Therefore, if you know an MS Amlin colleague will be in one of our offices on a particular date and it is absolutely necessary to meet them, please arrange to do so at another location, safely, in line with current social distancing requirements.
